Description

This workshop is aimed at Senior Civil Servants to assist them in gaining the skills and knowledge to create a powerful and credible personal presence impact. You will be shown techniques from theatre-practice, and will be allowed to explore how to use your body and voice as tools for effective communication and leadership.

If you're already an experienced communicator, this course takes your skills to the next level.

What does it involve?

This is a 2-day workshop consisting of a mixture of practical tasks and exercises, debriefs, individual feedback and coaching, and scenario-based sessions where you will:

- Investigate your own personal impact.
- Increase your awareness of how you come across to others.
- Develop your interpersonal and relational skills further.

In the safe environment of the workshop, you're encouraged to experiment and test out principles, apply the learning to real-life situations using your own approach, and receive personalised feedback. You may want to focus on an area of communication you're keen to improve, or that has been identified as a development area.

What's the outcome?

On completing the workshop you will have the confidence to take risks in your communications to create maximum engagement and influence. You will experience how to use your voice as a tool for positive communication and authenticity. You will also have the knowledge of how to create a positive environment in the workplace by focusing on the positive traits of others
